At that time Jesus said to his disciples: "Not everyone who says to me "Lord, Lord" will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. Whoever hears these words of mine and does them is like the wise man who built his house on rock. The rain fell, the floods overflowed, the winds blew and beat against the house, but it did not collapse, because it was built on rock.

#### The Word of the Lord

» Let us be like those wise men who build on the rocks, in the firmness that in the face of difficulties they can stand. A moment of silence.

» Today's symbol is the person himself. We invite you to stand up. To feel the steadfastness to which the Gospel invites us, that steadfastness that we want to transmit... to form citizens of the Kingdom.

#### COMMUNITY PRAYER: YOU WILL BE CHAMPAGNAT TODAY (KAIROS)

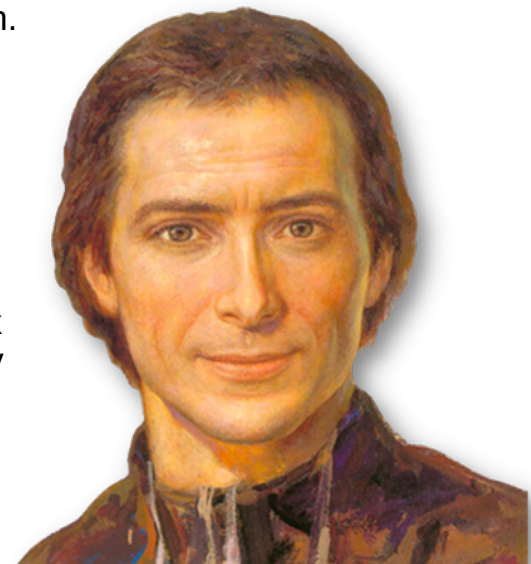
This story, which we all love, is not a memory, it is now a reality; in you, in me is his love, which makes us walk.

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## BLOCK III - BEST PRACTICE FAIR: ONGOING RESPONSES

The dynamics to be followed are as follows:

- The fair will last an hour and a half, and the time will be divided into 3 half-hour slots. Participants will have to remain at their stand explaining their proposal, which they will present every 10 minutes (3 times) at each stand that has a turn to present. The remaining two slots will be devoted to visiting and getting to know the rest of the stands that interest them.
- According to the proposed dynamics, it will be possible to attend the presentation of 3 practices in one block and another 3 practices in a second block.

## BLOCK IV - WORLD CAFÉ. HOW CAN CHAMPAGNAT GLOBAL RESPOND TO THE SCHOOL OF THE FUTURE AND TO THE INTERESTS AND CONCERNS OF THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY?

- There will be 8 tables where groups of 8-9 people will participate. Each table will have a flipchart with one of the topics that came up in the morning and the corresponding group will have to contribute by answering the question that appears on the flipchart. The group will move around each table, on a cue, every 7 minutes. The idea is that Champagnat Global can take note of possible responses to the interests shown by the school community.
- **At the end of the round**, the contributions made at each table will be presented (2 minutes presentation per table).
