JESUS CALLS US TO WEAVE NETS



INTRODUCTION

We prepare ourselves to pray, helping ourselves with the awareness of how each one of us is, body and heart (one minute of silence). Thank God and make the sign of the cross, with the certainty of his presence.

GENERATE THE SYMBOL

Standing up, take the strip of paper and calmly stretch and walk to the rhythm of the music, trying to connect everyone's strips, weaving, and lifting to see that no one is left out, unconnected. To observe the figure formed by all; to place ourselves as part of a whole. Called together from diverse cultures and languages, but united in the same mission, together we await the coming of the Messiah, as the prophet Isaiah reminds us. Pause and from there listen to the Word of God.

A READING FROM THE PROPHET ISAIAH (Is 11,1)

The day will come, when a shoot will sprout from the stump of Jesse, and a shoot shall blossom out of his root. The spirit of the Lord shall rest upon it: the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and strength, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord.



The word of the Lord

➤ After a moment of silence, some may express a phrase that expresses what is in our heart with this symbol and this reading.

➤ Thanking the participants with a gesture of thanks, we return to our own places to conclude with a community prayer.
