INTRODUCTION

We prepare ourselves to pray, helping ourselves with the awareness of how each one of us is, the body, the heart (one minute of silence). Give thanks with the sign of the cross.

GENERATE THE SYMBOL

To note and be grateful for the vitality that each of us possesses, the strength and the breath of the Spirit that mobilises us. The symbol of the spinning wheel in the logo of this gathering expresses just that.

We invite you to take the cut sheet and to join the four corners with the staple. Today's gospel reading reminds us that we have been called to Marist work and that each one brings his or her own vitality to the mission, his or her own colour, his or her own life. How much do we leave behind that which detracts from our colour and movement?

A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO ST. MATTHEW (4, 18-22)

At that time, as Jesus was passing by the lake of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a cod end into the lake; for they were fishermen. He said to them, "Come, follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." Immediately they left the nets and followed him. And going on ahead, he saw two other brothers, James, son of Zebedee and John, who were in the boat going over the nets with their father Zebedee. Jesus called them also. Immediately they left the boat and their father and followed him.

Word of God...

- >> Invite some to express. Jesus, we want to follow you... and we offer you what we are...
- >> Jesus, we want to follow you... to join you and join forces to form a global family, and for that we go to the altar to leave the reef.
- He invites us to conclude with the prayer that was part of the XXII General Chapter, very timely for this day. First, we listen to those who speak English, then to those who speak Portuguese and finally to those who speak Spanish.
